Conditions: Entries must comply with the current version of the Surf Casting and Angling Club's Competition Rules, available from the club web site www.surfcasters.iinet.net.au, Club Recorder or Secretary.

- (1) The Recorder must receive the application **within 30 days** of capture .
- (2) **Entries must be complete with every detail, and all weights must be witnessed.**
- (3) Club member's scales may be used but must be submitted with this form for checking. Any variation will be adjusted to the weight claimed.
- (4) Witness to capture and / or weighing may be submitted on a separate declaration attached to this form.
- (5) Colour photograph of fish plus a ruler or an object of known size must be supplied.
- (6) A tooth from both upper and lower jaws shall accompany an application for a shark entry to allow identification.

Game Fish / Line ratio Competitions.

- (1) Nylon or wire leader (any kg) must not exceed 4.5 meters long.
- (2) 5 meters of used line to be submitted for testing.

Master and Species Competitions.

All fishing competitions will be run under the current version of the Club's "Competition Rules." An entry form is not required if the fish is separately weighed and recorded in the Field Day catch list. "Free choice" is any other eligible fish as listed in Competition Rules Eligible Species List, section 2.3.1.

Junior Master Angler

Fish must be caught on a Club Field Day. A Junior must capture five (5) of the listed species to qualify for a Junior Master Angler badge.

Master Angler

Fish must be caught on a Club Field Day. A member must capture eight (8) of the listed species to qualify for a Master Angler badge.

Grand Master Angler

Fish may be caught at any time including on Club Field Days. A member must capture eight (8) of the listed species to qualify for a Grand Master Angler badge. Entries for fish caught other than on Field Days must be submitted to the Recorder on the appropriate form.

Species Competition

1. Entries to be submitted to the Recorder on the appropriate form, unless caught on a Field Day.
2. Fish may be caught at any time including on Club Field Days.
3. A member must capture ten (10) of the listed species to qualify for a Species badge.
4. Weighing of fish, photographs and witnesses to weight are optional.
5. Fish must be a minimum of 20 cm or comply with Dept of Fisheries minimum lengths if these are greater
