The President

Norcape Lodge, Exmouth, have a strong association with us being the major donor to the Beach section of our successful Mandurah Open Angling Tournament.

They have approached us to obtain an idea of the support they would receive from the members of our association for a beach fishing competition to be held at Exmouth early in November.

It would run for about 7 days and the aim of the event is to catch world records from the shore. The basis therefore would probably be based on a weight to line size ratio, and therefore, all competitors would have an equal chance to win some of the valuable prizes. Even if an angler was not successful in winning the trip would be remembered for a long time for the tremendous fishing enjoyed in the area. Exmouth is where the 70lb. plus trawler was recently caught.

Accommodation at the lodge is very reasonable, where a fisherman's room is \$10 per night and with a full breakfast \$14.25 per night. There is other accommodation in the lodge at varying rates.

The Lodge caravan park holds 60 vans, and the rate there is a reasonable \$35 per week. As you can see it would not be expensive for an enjoyable week.

The possibility of the event being held depends on our support so final details are not completed but arrangements could be made for combining transport to ease fuel costs. There is a possibility also of a charter bus arrangement from Perth accommodation and travel at Exmouth and return to Perth for about \$200 per head for the competition.

I have left the anticipated prizes till last because they are tremendous.

- (1) The overall winner prize would be a 4 wheel drive vehicle.
- (2) The best male and female entrant other than the winner would receive a 28 day Jetpass holiday around Australia. Many other valuable prizes would also be available for day prizes.
- (3) In addition the first male and female entrant to catch a world record would each with partner be flown to Florida, America for 7 days to register the catch.

As you can see a fantastic prize list which would make many anglers interested in making the trip to this fishing paradis.

I point out though that the details including the prize list are to be confirmed but I need to know an approximate number by say 21st. April of members who hope to make the trip. Unless 300 anglers are interested it would not be worth the time and promotion to run the event.

Could you ask your members and drop me a line of the numbers who could be interested and the club's opinion of the event as soon as know to the address shown earlier.
