FIELD DAY REPORT

VENUE ROTTNEST
DATE: SEPTEMBER 17TH -18TH 1988

We had seventeen anglers scattered around the West End, trying to find safe, reachable fishing territory. Mal White gave us all hope by bagging two nice Salmon at Cathedral Hole in his first half hour of fishing. Malcolm Head had a Salmon on with which to christen his brand new rod, but he blew it!!!! He also lost a nice fish off Radar Reef on Sunday morning, but didn't even see the colour of it. Malcolm also managed to spend time entertaining the rest of us by falling in reef holes. Cookie landed a nice bream at Cathedral, while the F.D.O. actually had a nice 2kg tailor in her hands, then dropped it. (Yes- a tailor from Cathedral.)

The Reeley's got a good start on herring at Wilsons, but the swell chased them out. Derry Barber got himself a new nick name ("Buffy" Barber), while Heath Holman had a good shark run on the Saturday morning.

D'Alonzos and Osbornes tried Fish Hook Saturday evening, and while no keepable fish were landed, there was quite an assortment of catches, ranging from huge lumps of seaweed to a variety of sharks. Tony broke his rod when he broke off and hit the rocks with the recoil. Even here the swell got the better of us, absolutely drenching the ledge. As we were having a picnic supper at the time and there were lumps of bread, cheese and hot salami floating around Fish Hook for some time after.
